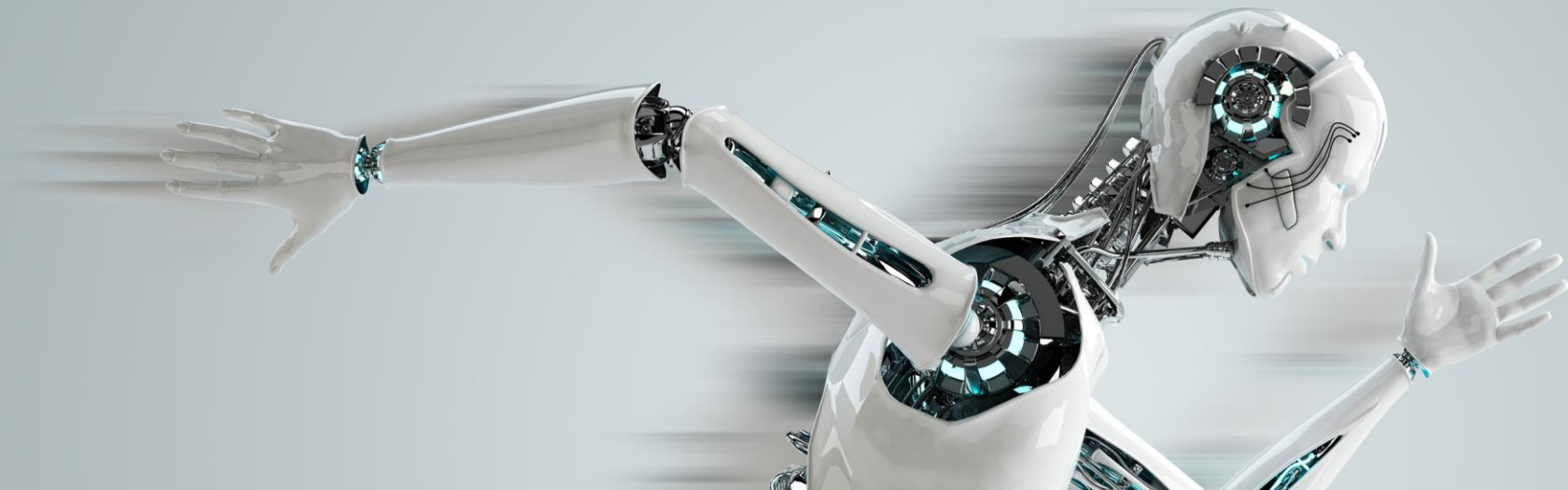

▪ redline on-premise

- European sales
- Reuse components for the cloud
- Support for on-premise customers
- Future major releases planned

▪ redline cloud

- U.S. sales
- Application Platform as a Service (aPaaS)
- Salesforce model
- Can not be done overnight
- Learn from SaaS

▪ Merging of technologies

- At some future point merge both technologies
- Migrate redline customers to redline cloud with hybrid approach: same technology and code, running either on-premise or in the public cloud

redline 6.0 key results

- Mobile is back
 - Web Components for tablets and phones
 - Build support for mobile devices
- Improved integration with Windows Desktop
 - Agent 2.0
- Further improvements of client customizing framework
 - Result list as a plugin
 - Document Viewer as a plugin

redline 6.0 key results

- Modern Office integration is supported (also for redline cloud)
 - Addins for O365 Office & Outlook
- Lower the entry barrier for developers
 - Automatic generation of DMS API documentation (REST-WS)
- Technical improvements
 - Eliminate Java RMI API
 - Support clustering (in HA and load balancing configuration)

Minimum viable product SaaS: Use Cases

1

SaaS

multitenant schema, no customizing, tenant administers own users

2

Cloud archive

tenants may modify schema, no security, technical users/SAP Archive Link

3

“enterprise“ SaaS

tenant has complete control in his own instance, administered by OPTIMAL SYSTEMS

redline cloud 2.0 key results: MVP SaaS

- Provisioning of an end-user tenant
 - Tenant registration portal
 - Tenant specific schema
 - Tenant can modify own schema
 - End-user tenant can manage own users

redline cloud 2.0 key results: MVP SaaS

- Cloud based renditions
 - Free from Windows
 - Simple and fast (90% solution)
 - 3rd party OCR integration

redline cloud 2.0 key results: Webclient is back

- Webclient productive
 - Designed forms (text DSL), scripts (Form service)
 - Client customizing (eo-core)
 - Filing documents in client
 - Edit documents
 - Agent
- Dynamic context folders, structure service, catalogs
- User Service (favorites, locations, subscriptions, reminders, saved search, result list configuration, user settings such as name, email, picture or language)



- **From this point on, objectives of future redline cloud versions, no time frame, likely to change in the future**

redline cloud 3-6

1 redline cloud 3.0 – tenant customization, developer tools, redline AI

2 redline cloud 4.0 – BPM is back

3 redline cloud 5.0 – redline goes platform as a service

4 redline cloud 6.0 – redline is platform as a service

When can I migrate?

- For DMS projects: from redline cloud 2.0
- For BPM projects: from redline cloud 4.0
